The CR pathways focus on enhancing writing and reading skills to better prepare students for English Language and Literature exams in international curricula, such as Cambridge and the International Baccalaureate.

Selam Learning Program Descriptions

College Readiness 9 (8 months)

This program is designed to empower students with the skills needed to become confident and competent communicators.
